

ORDINANCE NO. 2365

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO GARBAGE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL AND AMENDING SECTION 16.12.010 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 16.12.010 of the Kirkland Municipal Code be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

16.12.010 [Bids and] Award of contract. No later than one hundred fifty days prior to the expiration of any existing contract for garbage collection, the city shall [prepare] commence preparation of specifications, and thereafter advertise and call for bids and from the bids received award the contract for the collection and disposal of all refuse within the city[-]; provided, however, that the City Council by Resolution may authorize the City Manager or the Director of the Department of Administration and Finance as his delegate to negotiate for the award of a new contract for garbage collection or the extension of of any existing garbage collection contract. No contract [so awarded] nor the extension of an existing contract shall run for a period in excess of five years. Upon the award of contract, the contractor shall furnish a corporate surety bond to the city in the sum of [five] one hundred thousand dollars conditioned upon full and faithful performance of his contract and compliance with all laws, statutes, ordinances, rules and regulations relating to his business and the collection and disposal of refuse. Such contract shall contain a prohibition against assignment thereof or transfer of any interest therein without consent of the city and it shall contain a suitable provision provided for the forfeiture of the agreement for nonperformance of the terms and conditions of the contract and this title.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
