

ORDINANCE NO. 2367

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO VOLUNTEER FIREMEN FINDING THAT THE METHOD AND MANNER FOR COMPUTING SUCH COMPENSATION AS SET FORTH IN SECTION 3.64.050, KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE IS OBSOLETE AND REPEALING SAID SECTION.

WHEREAS, Section 3.64.050 of the Kirkland Municipal Code as adopted by Ordinance No. 987 in 1965, sets forth a method and manner for computing compensation to be paid to volunteer members of the Kirkland Fire Department, which method and manner of computation is no longer used and is obsolete and said section should therefore be repealed.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. Section 3.64.050 of the Kirkland Municipal Code be and it hereby is repealed.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the City Council in publication as required by law.
