ORDINANCE NO. 2439

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SCHEDULE OF FEES TO BE PAID TO THE CITY FOR CERTAIN SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE KIRKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT AND ESTABLISHING CHAPTER 5.74 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE AND TO AMEND CHAPTER 3.84 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, the City incurs certain costs in Kirkland Police Department performing certain services that are not now being reimbursed to the City; and

WHEREAS, those costs not now being reimbursed to the City are properly collectible by the City to cover the costs of providing said services,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Title 5 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of Chapter 5.74, to read as follows:

CHAPTER 5.74

FEES AS REIMBURSEMENT

SECTIONS:

- 010 Purpose
- 020 Fee schedule established for payment to the City of Kirkland costs of certain services rendered by the Kirkland Police Department

5.74.010 Purpose

The provisions of this chapter shall be deemed an exercise of the power of the City to obtain reimbursement for certain costs incurred and be consistent with the provisions of Article 8 Section 7 of the Constitution of the State of Washington.

5.74 .020 Fee schedule established for payment to the City of <u>Kirkland costs of certain services rendered by the Kirkland</u> Police Department.

Persons seeking and obtaining the following services as provided by the Kirkland Police Department, shall pay the following amounts for each instance such service is provided.

- (1) Fingerprinting \$ 4.00
- (2) Serving papers (whether or not successful) 10.00
- (3) Applicants to take the written examinations for the position of police officer shall reimburse the City in an amount not less than \$4.00 and not more than \$7.00, as determined by the appropriate testing service to reflect actual City cost; provided that a declaration of indigency by the applicant under this subsection shall excuse the imposition of this fee.

<u>Section 2</u>. Chapter 3.84 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended to include a new section to read as follows:

<u>3.84.045 Fees schedule established.</u> Fees required to be paid to the City of Kirkland pursuant to this chapter are as follows:

(1) Accident Reports

2.00 + .25 per page

(2) Criminal or traffic Defendants requests for Discovery

.25 per page

Section 3. Fees not refundable.

No portion of any fee requested to be paid pursuant to this ordinance shall be refunded or refundable, provided that a fee may be refunded where a refund request is made to the City prior to the City having incurred any cost or expended effort incomplying with the request for that service giving rise to the fee.

<u>Section 4</u>. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, part or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
