## ORDINANCE NO. 2449

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND PROHIBITING THE PRESENCE OF DOGS WITHIN CERTAIN CITY OF KIRKLAND PARKS DURING CERTAIN PERIODS OF TIME AND AUTHORIZING THE IMPOUNDING OF ANY DOGS FOUND WITHIN SAID PARKS DURING SAID PROHIBITED TIME PERIOD.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Dogs prohibited in waterfront parks: No dogs shall be permitted within any of the following City of Kirkland parks during the period indicated:

PARK

DOGS PROHIBITED

MARINA PARK

Between January 1 and December 31, inclusive in each year (at all times).

ALL OTHER WATERFRONT PARKS

Between June 1 and October 1, inclusive of each year.

For the purposes of this section "waterfront park" means any City of Kirkland park situate along the shoreline of Lake Washington and includes Houghton Beach Park, Marsh Park, South Kirkland Park, Marina Park, Waverly Park and Kiwanis Park.

No owner or keeper of any dog shall permit such dog to enter or be within any of the parks listed hereinabove during the times when dogs are prohibited therefrom. Any dog within any of said parks during the time in which dogs are prohibited therein, shall be subject to immediate impoundment pursuant to the provisions for impounding of dogs contained in Section 8.03.050 of the Kirkland Municipal Code.

Section 2. This ordinance shall constitute a new section in chapter 8.04--Animal Control--Kirkland Municipal Code, and in Chapter 11.80--Park Rules--Kirkland Municipal Code.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
