

ORDINANCE NO. 2462

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, VACATING THAT PORTION OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY KNOWN AS NORTHEAST 66 STREET LYING WITHIN THE PLAT OF MURIEL D. POAGE ADDITION TO HOUGHTON.

WHEREAS, by resolution heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, date was set for public hearing upon the proposed vacation of public right of way as more fully hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of said hearing was held in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, following said public hearing held May 7, 1979, a vote of the Council was taken favoring said vacation; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be desirable and to the best interests of the city, its residents and the property owners abutting thereon that said public right of way be vacated,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described portion of public right of way situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows is hereby vacated:

All of that portion of Northeast 66 Street lying within the plat of Muriel D. Poage Addition to Houghton, as recorded in Volume 57 of Plats, page 86, records of King County.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
