

ORDINANCE NO. 2463

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, VACATING THAT PORTION OF PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY KNOWN AS TOTEM LAKE WAY WITHIN THE PLAT OF TOTEM LAKE SOUTH.

WHEREAS, by resolution heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, date was set for public hearing upon the proposed vacation of public right of way as more fully hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of said hearing was held in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, following said public hearing held May 7, 1979, a vote of the Council was taken favoring said vacation; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be desirable and to the best interests of the city, its residents and the property owners abutting thereon that said public right of way be vacated,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:


Section 1. The following specifically described portion of public right of way situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows is hereby vacated:

That portion of Totem Lake Way in Section 28, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M. with common frontage on lots 1 through 5 and Tracts A and B of the plat of Totem Lake South recorded in Volume 110 of Plats, pages 9 through 11, records of King County.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.

PASSED by the Kirkland City Council in regular meeting on the 7th day of May, 1979.


