

ORDINANCE NO. 2526

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS EXTENDING THE TERM OF NEWLY APPOINTED BOARD MEMBERS FROM THREE YEARS TO FOUR YEARS AND AMENDING SECTION 3.36.030 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 3.36.030 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3.36.030 Terms of commissioners--Filing vacancies. Of the several terms of office of the initial board, two terms shall expire in one year, two terms shall expire in two years, and three terms shall expire in three years. The first commissioners appointed shall determine by lot whose terms shall expire in one, two and three years respectively, and their terms shall begin after their appointment has been approved by the city council, and upon taking the usual oath of qualification. The terms of office, except the first, shall begin on the first Monday in January, and at the expiration of each commissioner's term, the mayor shall appoint, with the consent of the city council, a successor for a /three/ four year terms. Members of the board may be removed at any time by the mayor, with concurrence by the city council, and vacancies for the remainder of unexpired terms shall be filled in the same manner in which original appointments are made."

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication as required by law.
