

ORDINANCE NO. 2534

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE SALE AND DISPOSITION OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY, AUTHORIZING TRANSFER THEREOF TO ANY GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY BY NEGOTIATION, AND AMENDING SECTION 3.86.020 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 3.86.020 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3.86.020 Sale of personal property of three hundred dollars in value or less /: or to another governmental entity. Approval of the council is given for the sale or disposition of any personal property:

A. With an estimated value of three hundred dollars or less, or


B. To another governmental entity to be used by that entity /which/

when such property has been certified for disposition by the city manager; such sale or disposition to be made by the purchasing agent in accordance with informal procedures and in the best interest of the city."

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the City Council and publication as required by law.


