ORDINANCE NO. 2552

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND INCREASING THE MONTHLY SEWER SERVICE CHARGE TO BE PAID BY CUSTOMERS OF THE KIRKLAND SEWER SYSTEM TO REFLECT THE INCREASED SEWER RATE TO BE CHARGED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF METROPOLITAN SEATTLE (METRO) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1981, AND AMENDING CHAPTER 15.24 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 15.24.070 of the Kirkland Municipal Code relating to monthly sewer service rates is hereby amended to read as follows:

"15.24.070 Monthly sewer rates. The monthly sewer charge required to be paid to the city by customers of the sewer system is established as follows:

(1) Single family residence: eight dollars and (fifteen) seventy-five cents;

(2) Multi-family residence, including duplex: One dollar and fifty cents per month per unit or apartment, plus ninety (four) seven cents per one hundred cubic feet of water consumed.

(3) All other sewer customers: Ninety-sevencents per one hundred cubic feet of water consumed; provided, however, that the monthly rate per customers or establishment shall be not less than eight dollars and (fifteen) seventy-five cents.

Section 2. The increase in monthly sewer service rate provided for by Section 1 of this amendatory ordinance, shall be in full force and effect as of November 1, 1980.

Section 3. Except as provided in Section 2 hereof, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage by the City Council and publication as required by law.
