ORDINANCE NO. 2564



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE KIRKLAND WATER-SEWER SYSTEM, ADJUSTING CERTAIN RATES FOR WATER SERVICE AND AMENDING CHAPTER 15.24 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 15.24.040 of the Kirkland Municipal Code, relating to monthly service and consumption rates for water service, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 15.24.020 Water consumption charge. In addition to the basic monthly rate, the charge for water consumed during the billing period (bi-monthly) shall be:

(1) For residential customers: (Ferty-cents)forty-six

cents per one hundred cubic feet of water consumed;

(2) For non-residential customers: (Ferty-five-cents)

fifty-one cents per one hundred cubic feet of water consumed;

Where the basic rate includes some water consumption

(single family residential customers) the consumption rate

shall be calculated on water consumed in excess of the amount
included in the basic rate.

Section 2. The rate adjustments herein provided shall become effective as to each customer as of the first day of ________, 1981.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
