ORDINANCE 0-4691

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO STREET USE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR PERFORMANCE BONDS, INSURANCE AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS AND AMENDING SECTION 19.04.064 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 19.04.064 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is amended to read as follows.

19.04.064 Performance bond-Security Device, insurance, other requirements.

Prior to issuance of the street use permit, the applicant shall file with the city the following:

(a) An agreement, approved by the city, wherein the applicant agrees to defend, save, and hold harmless the city of Kirkland;

- (b) The permittee shall obtain, at its sole expense, comprehensive liability insurance, with limits of not less than three hundred thousand dollars per occurrence, and shall provide the city with satisfactory proof of continued insurance coverage during the life of the permit. Such insurance shall include the city of Kirkland as an additional named insured;
- (c) File with the city, on a form approved by the city attorney, a performance bond issued by a surety company licensed to do business in the state of Washington security device. Such bond device shall be in the amount of one thousand dollars and conditioned upon the permittee's faithful performance of all conditions and requirements of the permit.

<u>Section 2</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
