## ORDINANCE NO. 2584

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, VACATING A PORTION OF N.E. 84TH STREET (4TH AVENUE), EAST OF 6TH STREET, FILED BY BRIAN LURIE, FILE NO.VC-81-13

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R-2797 heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, date was set for public hearing upon the proposed vacation of a portion of N.E. 84th Street (4th Avenue), east of 6th Street as more fully hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of said hearing was held in accordance with law, and

WHEREAS, following said public hearing, held March 16, 1981, a vote of the Council was taken favoring said vacation, and

WHEREAS, it appears desirable and to the best interest of the City, its residents and property owners abutting thereon that said street be vacated, and

WHEREAS, no property will be denied direct access as a result of the Vacation.

NOW, 'THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A portion of a street situated in Kirkland, King County, Washington and described as follows:

The South 5 feet of the North 22 feet of the following:

The North half of the following described tract, EXCEPT the South 100 feet thereof;

Beginning at a point which bears from the South quarter corner of Section 5, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, North 4°28'36" West 532.74 feet and running thence South 87°02'20" West 92.85 feet more or less to the East line of 108th Avenue Northeast; thence along said line North 3°13'45" West 456.68 feet; thence North 86°49'26" East 166.88 feet; thence South 4°28'36" East 457.58 feet to the North line of Northeast 82nd Street; thence South 87°02'20" West 84.01 feet to the point of beginning.

(Being known as the North half of Lots 32 and 32A, EXCEPT the South 100 feet thereof, BURKE & FARRAR'S KIRKLAND GARDENS, DIVISION NO. 15, according to unrecorded plat thereof).

be and the same hereby is vacated, except that the City shall retain and reserve an easement, together with the right to exercise and grant easements along, over and across said vacated street for the installation, construction, repair and maintenance of public utilities and services.

Section 2. Subsequent to the passage of this Ordinance, the City Clerk shall receive a recorded copy of a legal easement for public pedestrian access across the below described property. The City Clerk must receive this easement document before the Director of Administration and Finance signs this Ordinance for recording with the King County Department of Elections and Records. The property to be subject to said easement is described as follows: The westerly four feet of the following:

The North half of the following described tract, EXCEPT the South 100 feet thereof; and  $\frac{\text{EXCEPT}}{\text{the North}}$  17 feet thereof;

Beginning at a point which bears from the South quarter corner of Section 5, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, North  $4^028'36"$  West 532.74 feet and running thence South  $87^002'20"$  West 92.85 feet more or less to the East line of 108th Avenue Northeast; thence along said line North  $3^013'45"$  West 456.68 feet; thence North  $86^049'26"$  East 166.88 feet; thence South  $4^028'36"$  East 457.58 feet to the North line of Northeast 82nd Street; thence south  $87^002'20"$  West 84.01 feet to the point of beginning;

(Being known as the North half of Lots 32 and 32A, EXCEPT the South 100 feet thereof, Burke and Farrar's Kirkland Gardens, Division No. 15, according to unrecorded plat thereof).

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law and upon compliance with all conditions imposed.
