

ORDINANCE NO. 2600

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES AND AMENDING SECTION 1.08.010 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE TO CONFORM TO THE PROVISIONS OF RCW 35A.12.160.

Whereas, RCW 35A.12.160 relating to the publication of ordinances, adopted by code cities requires:

"Promptly after adoption, every ordinance shall be published verbatim at least once in a newspaper printed and published within the City such publication to be made in the city's official newspaper, if there is one. If there is no official newspaper or other newspaper printed and published within the city, then publication shall be made by printing and posting the ordinance in at least three public places in the city, designated by ordinance as the official posting places for city notices."; and

Whereas, there is no newspaper presently being printed and published within the city limits of the City of Kirkland; and

Whereas, the provisions of Section 1.08.010 of the Kirkland Municipal Code relating to publication of ordinances, is inconsistent with RCW 35A.12.160, now, therefore

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 1.08.010 of the Kirkland Municipal Code be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

1.08.010 Required publications. All ordinances of the City, shall promptly after adoption be published at least once in a newspaper printed and published within the City; provided, however, if there is no newspaper printed and published within the City, then publication shall be made by printing and posting the ordinance in, at least, the following three public places, which are hereby designated as the official posting places for City notices: (i) the official bulletin board located in the entrance hall at City Hall, Kirkland, Washington; (ii) the bulletin board located at the official City depository (bank); and (iii) the Kirkland Public Library.

All notices of hearings before the Kirkland City Council, Kirkland Planning Commission and Kirkland Board of Adjustment and all other matters requiring publication, shall be published at least once in a legal newspaper, published and/or circulated in the City.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage and posting or publication as required by law.
