

ORDINANCE NO. 2623

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO BUSINESS AND OCCUPATION TAXES, AND PROVIDING THAT THE CHANGES THERETO ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2610 SHALL NOT TAKE EFFECT UNTIL JANUARY 1, 1982, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2610

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2610 the City of Kirkland amended its business and occupation taxes in relation to "competitive telephone service" in order to conform with the provisions of Chapter 144, Laws of 1981, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 144, Laws of 1981, does not become effective until January 1, 1982, and the changes made in the City of Kirkland business and occupation tax structure by Ordinance No. 2610 should not become effective until January 1, 1982, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1: Section 4 of Ordinance No. 2610 adopted by the Kirkland City Council on August 3, 1981, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the City Council and posting or publication as required by law or January 1, 1982, whichever shall last occur.

Section 2: This amendatory ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the City Council and posting or publication as required by law.

PASSED by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular meeting on the 17th day of August, 1981.


