

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND INCREASING THE MONTHLY SEWER SERVICE CHARGE TO BE PAID BY CUSTOMERS OF THE KIRKLAND SEWER SYSTEM TO REFLECT THE INCREASED SEWER RATE TO BE CHARGED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF METROPOLITAN SEATTLE (METRO) BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1982, AND AMENDING CHAPTER 15.24 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 15.24.070 of the Kirkland Municipal Code relating to monthly sewer service rates is hereby amended to read as follows:

"15.24.070 Monthly sewer rates. The monthly sewer charge required to be paid to the city by customers of the sewer system is established as follows:

(1) Single family residence: ~~(eight-dollars-and-seventy-five)~~ nine dollars and twenty cents;

(2) Multi-family residence, including duplex: One dollar and fifty cents per month per unit or apartment, plus ~~(ninety-seven)~~ one dollar and two cents per one hundred cubic feet of water consumed.

(3) All other sewer customers: ~~(Ninety-seven-cents)~~ One dollar and two cents per one hundred cubic feet of water consumed; provided, however, that the monthly rate per customers or establishment shall be not less than ~~(eight-dollars-and-seventy-five)~~ nine dollars and twenty cents.

Section 2. The increase in monthly sewer service rate provided for by Section 1 of this amendatory ordinance, shall be in full force and effect as of December 1, 1981.


Section 3. Except as provided in Section 2 hereof, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage by the City Council and posting as required by law.


