

ORDINANCE NO. 2646

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ACKNOWLEDGING THE EXTENSION OF THE EXISTENCE OF THE HOUGHTON COMMUNITY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION FOR AN ADDITIONAL FOUR-YEAR TERM.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. There is hereby added to Chapter 2.16 of the Kirkland Municipal Code a new section to read as follows:

Section 2.16.040 Term Extended. Pursuant to the approval of the voters within the Houghton Community Municipal Corporation as expressed at a general municipal election held November 3, 1981, the existence of the Houghton Municipal Community shall be extended for an additional four-year term to end on the first Monday of January, 1986.


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication or posting as required by law.

Passed by the Kirkland City Council in regular meeting on the 4th day of January, 1982.




