AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND REDUCING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE KIRKLAND PLANNING COMMISSION FROM NINE MEMBERS TO SEVEN MEMBERS AND AMENDING SECTION 3.32.010 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. Section 3.32.010 be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

3.32.010 Membership--Appointment--Compensation. The planning commission of the city shall be composed of [~~nine~~] seven members appointed by the mayor without regard to political affiliation from among the residents of the city. Such appointments shall be subject to confirmation by the city council. The members of the planning commission shall serve without compensation.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the City council and posting or publishing as required by law.


