RESOLUTION R-5391

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELINQUISHING ANY INTEREST THE CITY MAY HAVE, EXCEPT FOR A UTILITY EASEMENT, IN UNOPENED RIGHT-OF-WAY AS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND REQUESTED BY PROPERTY OWNERS EVAN C. BLAKE AND DANIEL GILLISON.

WHEREAS, the City has received a request to recognize that any rights to the land originally dedicated in 1890 as right-of-way abutting a portion of Town of Kirkland have been vacated by operation of law; and

WHEREAS, the Laws of 1889, Chapter 19, Section 32, provide that any county road that remains unopened for five years after authority is granted for opening the same is vacated by operation of law at that time; and

WHEREAS, the area that is the subject of this request was part of the incorporation of the City of Kirkland in 1905, with the relevant right-of-way having been unopened; and

WHEREAS, in consideration for reimbursing the administrative costs for doing so and granting the City a utility easement in the vacated area, the City is willing to recognize the vacation may have occurred.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

 <u>Section 1</u>. As requested by the property owners Evan Blake and Daniel Gillison, the City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby recognizes that the following described rights-of-way may have been vacated by operation of law and relinquishes all interest it may have, except for a utility easement, in that portions of right-of-way described as follows:

The north 8 feet of the unopened alley, or whatever portion remains for recognition of possible vacation by this Resolution, abutting the south boundary of the following described property: Lots 10 and 11, Block 173, Town of Kirkland, according to the plat thereof, recorded in Volume 6 of Plats, page 53, in King County, Washington.

<u>Section 2</u>. This resolution does not affect any third-party rights in the property, if any.
