

ORDINANCE NO. 2702

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON,
REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 660.

WHEREAS, Chapter 17.21 of the Revised Code of Washington establishes regulations requiring that pest control operators obtain a license from the State Department of Agriculture. This Chapter preempts the ability of the City to require licensing of these operators; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance is exempt from the requirements of the State Environmental Policies Act under WAC 197-10-170 (5), (11) and (21).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 660 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the City Council and publication as required by law.

PASSED by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular, open meeting this Fourth day of October.

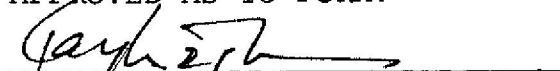

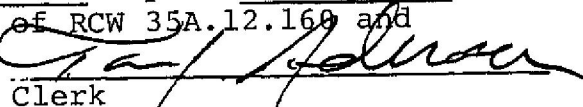
