ORDINANCE NO. 2750 revealed 0-3505

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND PROHIBITING COMMER-CIAL SOLICITATION AT PRIVATE RESIDENCES.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 11.48 of the Kirkland Municipal Code, entitled TRESPASS, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. There is hereby created a new chapter to be known as Chapter 11.48, entitled PEDDLERS, and to read as follows:

11.48.010 Peddlers Prohibited. The practice of being in and upon private residences in the city, not having been requested or invited so to do by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of the private residences, for the purpose of commercial solicitation is prohibited.

11.48.020 Commercial solicitation--What constitutes. Commercial solicitation carries its common, ordinary and popular meaning and includes, but is not limited to, the activities of peddlers, canvassers, itinerant merchants, and persons who offer to sell articles of trade or commerce to be delivered then or in the future, or solicit orders or subscriptions for themselves or others, or exhibit for sale goods, wares or merchandise.

11.48.030 Certain persons exempt. A. The provisions of Sections 11.48.010 and 11.48.020 of this chapter shall not apply to any person, organization or association when engaged in a charitable solicitation provided that such person, organization, or association is not in violation of either Chapter 7.56, Kirkland Municipal Code, or RCW Chapter 19.09 relating to regulation of charitable solicitation activities.

B. The provisions of Section 11.48.010 and 11.48.020 of this chapter shall not apply to any farmer, gardener or other person while selling, delivering, or peddling any perishable edibles raised, caught, produced or manufactured by that person or that person's family.
