AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO ALARMS AND ADDING CHAPTER 21.35A TO THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby created a new chapter to be known as Chapter 21.35A, entitled ELECTRONIC SECURITY DEVICES, and to read as follows:


21.35A.010 Automatic Linkage Prohibited. The installation or use of any electric, electronic or mechanical security device which gives automatic notice to the communications center of the Kirkland Police Department, is prohibited, except by federal, state or local government agencies acting with the permission of the Chief of Police, Kirkland Police Department. This provision specifically includes devices utilizing the public telephone system.

21.35A.020 Enforcement. Violators of Section 21.35A.010 shall be subject to the enforcement provisions of this title.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and posting or publication, as required by law.

Passed by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular, open meeting this 18th day of July, 1983.




