AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO ALARMS AND ADDING CHAPTER 21.35B TO THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby created a new chapter to be known as Chapter 21.35B, entitled ELECTRONIC FIRE ALARM DEVICES, and to read as follows:

21.35B.010 Automatic Linkage Prohibited. The installation or use of any electric, electronic, or mechanical alarm device which gives automatic notice to the communications center of the Kirkland Fire Department on emergency or business telephone numbers is prohibited. Individuals, agencies or companies may use the special telephone line for automatic notification when approved by the Director of Fire Services. This provision specifically includes devices utilizing the public telephone system.

21.35B.020 Enforcement. Violators of Section 21.35B.010 shall be subject to the enforcement provisions of this title.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and posting or publication, as required by law.


