

ORDINANCE NO. 2795

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO FEES FOR MOORAGE AT KIRKLAND MARINA PARK AND AMENDING SECTION 14.36.011 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 14.36.011 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

14.26.011 Rates established. There are established the following rates to be assessed against boats and other watercraft moored overnight at the Kirkland Marina Park moorage facility:

<u>BOAT OR WATERCRAFT LENGTH</u>	<u>RATE PER WATERCRAFT PER DAY</u>
Under 20 feet	\$ 4.00
21 feet to 30 feet	5.00
30 feet to 34 feet	6.00
[30] 35 feet to 40 feet	\$ [6.00] 8.00
41 feet to 50 feet	10.00
[41] 51 feet and over	[7.00] 15.00

For the purpose of this chapter, each day constitutes a period of twenty-four hours commencing at the time the watercraft is registered and payment made or from the time the watercraft is tied up, whichever first occurs.

Moorage or lying time at the Marina Park facility shall not exceed three days or a maximum of 72 hours in any consecutive seven-day period.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and posting or publication, as required by law; provided, however that the rate increase set forth in Section 1 shall go into effect on April 15, 1984.
