ORDINANCE No. 2806

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO DANCE HALLS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Sections 7.24.050, 7.24.060, and 7.24.070 of the Kirkland Municipal Code are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Section 7.24.040 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

7.24.040 Dance--Permit Required--Fee. It is unlawful to hold a public dance whether or not such public dance takes place on premises licensed as a public dance hall, without first having obtained a permit therefor from the City at least forty-eight hours prior to the commencement of the public dance for which said permit is requested. The fee for dance permits shall be ~~ten~~ twenty-five dollars for the giving or holding of each dance, provided however, that such fee shall be waived as to current and valid dance hall licenses and cabaret dance licenses when the dance is to be held upon the licensed premises.

Section 3. Chapter 7.24 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding a new section to be known as Section 7.24.050, entitled, Unlawful Operation, and to read as follows:

7.24.050 Unlawful operation. It is unlawful for a person or business to whom a dance hall license or permit has been issued including any owners, officers or employees, thereof, to conduct the dance or other activity in violation of any applicable state or local law, statute or ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and posting or publication, as required by law.

Passed by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular, open meeting this 16th day of April, 1984.
