RESOLUTION R-5410

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE DULY-APPOINTED ADMINISTERING AGENCY FOR A REGIONAL COALITION FOR HOUSING (ARCH) TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE FUNDING OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECTS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE ARCH EXECUTIVE BOARD, UTILIZING FUNDS FROM THE CITY'S HOUSING TRUST FUND.

WHEREAS, A Regional Coalition for Housing (ARCH) was created by interlocal agreement to help coordinate the efforts of Eastside cities to provide affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, the ARCH Executive Board has recommended that the City of Kirkland participate in the funding of a certain affordable housing project hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, the ARCH Executive Board has developed a number of recommended conditions to ensure that the City's affordable housing funds are used for their intended purpose and that projects maintain their affordability over time; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution R-4804 on March 2, 2010, approving the Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement for ARCH; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to use \$1,143,775 from the City's Housing Trust Funds and \$267,425 from Community Development Block Grant Funds as designated below to finance the projects recommended by the ARCH Executive Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council authorizes the duly-appointed administering agency of ARCH, pursuant to the Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement for ARCH, to execute all documents and take all necessary actions to enter into Agreements on behalf of the City with:

Imagine Housing Samma Senior Apartments in an amount not to exceed \$267,425;

Congregations for the Homeless East King County Men's Permanent Shelter in an amount not to exceed \$118,840;

Inland Group Polaris at Eastgate Apartments in an amount not to exceed \$136,675; and

Inland Group/Horizon Housing Alliance Together Center Redevelopment in an amount not to exceed \$653,600; and

Community Homes Shared Living Home 1 in an amount not to exceed \$23,890; and

Community Homes Adult Family Home 8 in an amount not to exceed \$35,770; and

Catholic Community Services with Sophia Way Women and Family Shelter in an amount not to exceed \$175,000.

Section 2. The agreements entered into pursuant to Section 1 of this Resolution shall be funded in a total amount not to exceed \$1,411,200. Such agreements shall include terms and conditions to ensure that the City's funds are used for their intended purpose and that the affordability of projects is maintained over time. In determining what conditions should be included in the agreements, the duly-appointed administering agency of ARCH shall be guided by the recommendations set forth in the ARCH Executive Board's memorandum as of December 27, 2019, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.
