

ORDINANCE NO. 2816*Repealed by 3368*

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE KIRKLAND WATER SYSTEM INCREASING THE WATER METER CHARGE PROVIDING FOR ANNUAL ADJUSTMENTS THERETO, AND AMENDING SUBSECTION 15.12.052(B) OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 15.12.052(b) of the Kirkland municipal code relating to the charge to be made for the installation of water meters, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

15.12.052(b) The meter charge shall be based upon the size of the meter required and determined as follows:

3/4-inch meter	<del>[\$190.00]</del>	\$260.00
1-inch meter	<del>[\$315.00]</del>	\$340.00
1 1/2-inch meter	<del>[\$590.00]</del>	\$620.00
2-inch meter	<del>[\$690.00]</del>	\$840.00
Any meter in excess of 2 inches in diameter		The actual cost of the meter, plus installation cost and a <del>[\$15.00]</del> \$40.00 administrative charge.

Any size meter furnished and installed at the expense of a property owner or developer, provided such meter has been approved by the director of public service.	<del>[\$30.00]</del>	\$40.00 inspection and administrative cost.

Annual adjustment in meter charge: Annually the director of public works shall adjust the foregoing meter charges in accordance with the following adjustment formula--the director shall determine for each meter size the average cost to the City for meter plus installation, using the actual cost of meter and installation for the immediate past 30 meter installations; provided that he shall exclude from the calculation, any meter installation occurring more than 3 years prior to the date of calculation, and any meter installation where the cost thereof was either 50 percent more than or 50 percent less than the calculated average cost. To the average cost shall be added \$40 and the sum thereof shall be the adjusted meter charge to be paid.



In the event the director is unable to arrive at an annual adjustment by using the foregoing formula, and he believes an adjustment is nevertheless appropriate, he shall request the City Council to approve an adjusted meter charge by ordinance amendment.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and posting or publication, as required by law.
