

ORDINANCE 2838

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO WATER DISTRIBUTION FACILITIES AND SERVICE, ADOPTING A WATER SYSTEM COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE KIRKLAND WATER SYSTEM SERVICE AREA, AND ADDING A NEW CHAPTER TO THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Whereas, the City of Kirkland operates a water distribution system for both domestic use and fire protection within a service area lying both within and without the Kirkland city limits; and

Whereas, there has been prepared and recommended to the Kirkland City Council a comprehensive water plan for the Kirkland water system service area and the water distribution facilities operated by the City of Kirkland; and

Whereas, said recommended water system plan has been coordinated with the land use and development policies of the Kirkland Comprehensive Plan (LUPP) together with the appropriate provisions of Section 13.24.010 and 14.44.050 of the King County Code, together with the regulations and guidelines adopted by the Department of Social and Health Services and codified as Section 248-54-580, Washington Administrative Code, now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Purpose: The purpose of this ordinance is to adopt consistent with the Kirkland Comprehensive Plan, and those appropriate provisions of Sections 13.24.010 and 14.44.050 of the King County Code, and Section 248-54-580 Washington Administrative Code, a Comprehensive Water Plan for the City of Kirkland water service area lying in part within the City of Kirkland and in part in adjacent unincorporated King County, and including all water distribution facilities of the Kirkland water system within said service area.

Section 2. Adoption by reference: The Comprehensive Water Plan prepared, published and recommended by the Kirkland Department of Public Works under the title, City of Kirkland Comprehensive Water Plan dated November 16, 1984, including worded text and maps are by this reference hereby adopted as the City of Kirkland Comprehensive Water Plan for the Kirkland water system service area as described in Section 1 of this ordinance.

Said publication has been endorsed with the title and number of this ordinance dated and signed by the Mayor, attested to by the Director of Administration and Finance (ex officio City Clerk) and is hereby incorporated herein as a part of this ordinance.

A copy of said publication shall be recorded in the office of the Director of Administration and Finance as a part of this ordinance and copies shall be filed in the following City departments for the use of the general public and the affected departments of the City: Department of Public Works, Building Department, Department of Planning and Community Development and the Department of Fire Services. Copies shall also be filed with those departments or agencies of King County and the State of Washington as may be required either by Chapter 13.24 or Chapter 14.44 of the King County Code, or Section 248-54-580, Washington Administrative Code.

Section 3. Severability Clause. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, part or portion of this ordinance including those portions herein adopted by reference is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 4. SEPA Compliance. An environmental checklist was submitted on the recommended comprehensive water plan adopted by this ordinance. The responsible official evaluated this proposal and issued a declaration of non-significance on October 12, 1984. This environmental information was made part of the record and accompanied the proposal and recommendation during its consideration by the City Council.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and posting or publication, as required by law.


