## ORDINANCE NO. 2840

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE YEAR 1985.

WHEREAS, public hearing to consider the proposed budget for the City of Kirkland for the year 1985 was duly and properly held on December 3, 1984 all in accordance with law, and

Whereas, following said hearing the City Council did approve and authorize such adjustments and changes as it deemed it necessary and proper and determined the allowances in each item, department, classification and fund,
