WHEREAS, the State of Washington and King County have each proclaimed an emergency to exist as a result of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager proclaimed an emergency to exist in Kirkland as a result of COVID-19 on February 29, 2020, which proclamation was ratified by the City Council through Resolution R-5411 on March 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has declared an emergency to exist as a result of COVID-19 and issued a major disaster declaration for the state of Washington in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the facts giving rise to such proclamations and declarations continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, among those most hurt by COVID-19 and needing immediate assistance are individuals in Kirkland needing food and shelter, mental health and domestic violence services, and other critical human services; and

WHEREAS, Art. XI, Sec. 11 of the Washington State Constitution grants the City broad police powers to "make and enforce within its limits all such local police, sanitary and other regulations as are not in conflict with general laws," including during public health emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to approve the proposed Human Services Stabilization Initiative and its Fiscal Note in the amount of \$265,000; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to authorize the City Manager to provide up to the remaining 2020 contracted human services grant amount for each contracted human services provider upon request from each such agency; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to authorize the City Manager to waive the 2020 Kirkland service goal requirements as a condition of receiving 2020 human services grant funds; and

WHEREAS, in light of the COVID-19 emergency it is necessary to take such action at a special meeting of the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council hereby approves the proposed Human Services Stabilization Initiative and its Fiscal Note in the amount of \$265,000 as set forth in Exhibit A hereto.

<u>Section 2</u>. The City Manager is authorized to provide funding up to the remaining 2020 contracted human services grant amount for each contracted service provider upon request from each such agency.

<u>Section 3</u>. The City Manager is authorized to waive the 2020 Kirkland service goal requirements for contracted service providers as a condition of receiving 2020 human services grant funds.
