

RESOLUTION R-5415

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPROVING A HUMAN SERVICES STABILIZATION INITIATIVE AND ITS FISCAL NOTE AND PROVIDING FOR THE PROVISION OF 2020 CONTRACTED GRANT AMOUNTS AND THE WAIVER OF AGENCY SERVICE GOAL REQUIREMENTS IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC EMERGENCY.

1 WHEREAS, the coronavirus identified as COVID-19 has
2 reached pandemic proportions throughout the world, including
3 the United States and the state of Washington; and
4

5 WHEREAS, the State of Washington and King County have
6 each proclaimed an emergency to exist as a result of COVID-19;
7 and
8

9 WHEREAS, the City Manager proclaimed an emergency to
10 exist in Kirkland as a result of COVID-19 on February 29, 2020,
11 which proclamation was ratified by the City Council through
12 Resolution R-5411 on March 3, 2020; and
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14 WHEREAS, the President of the United States has declared
15 an emergency to exist as a result of COVID-19 and issued a major
16 disaster declaration for the state of Washington in connection
17 therewith; and
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19 WHEREAS, the facts giving rise to such proclamations and
20 declarations continue to exist; and

22 WHEREAS, among those most hurt by COVID-19 and
23 needing immediate assistance are individuals in Kirkland needing
24 food and shelter, mental health and domestic violence services,
25 and other critical human services; and
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27 WHEREAS, Art. XI, Sec. 11 of the Washington State
28 Constitution grants the City broad police powers to "make and
29 enforce within its limits all such local police, sanitary and other
30 regulations as are not in conflict with general laws," including
31 during public health emergencies; and

33 WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to approve the proposed
34 Human Services Stabilization Initiative and its Fiscal Note in the
35 amount of \$265,000; and

36 WHEREAS, the Council wishes to authorize the City
37 Manager to provide up to the remaining 2020 contracted human
38 services grant amount for each contracted human services
39 provider upon request from each such agency; and

41 WHEREAS, the Council wishes to authorize the City
42 Manager to waive the 2020 Kirkland service goal requirements as
43 a condition of receiving 2020 human services grant funds; and

45 WHEREAS, in light of the COVID-19 emergency it is
46 necessary to take such action at a special meeting of the City
47 Council.

49 NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the
50 City of Kirkland as follows:
51

52 Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the
53 proposed Human Services Stabilization Initiative and its Fiscal
54 Note in the amount of \$265,000 as set forth in Exhibit A hereto.

56 Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to provide
57 funding up to the remaining 2020 contracted human services
58 grant amount for each contracted service provider upon request
59 from each such agency.

61 Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to waive the
62 2020 Kirkland service goal requirements for contracted service
63 providers as a condition of receiving 2020 human services grant
64 funds.
