

ORDINANCE 2880

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE SALARY OF THE COUNCILMEMBER SERVING AS MAYOR EFFECTIVE JANUARY, 1986 AND AMENDING SECTION 3.08.010 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 3.08.010 of the Kirkland Municipal Code ~~be and it~~ hereby is amended to read as follows:

3.08.010 Salaries--elected officials (councilmember, mayor). The salaries for elected officials are established to be as follows:

Councilmember [COUNCILMAN]: \$300.00 per month


The councilmember [COUNCILMAN] serving as mayor shall, while so serving, receive an additional: \$100.00 per month, provided that effective January 1, 1986 said additional amount shall be \$150.00 per month.

[The individuals holding the offices for which salaries are herein established shall be entitled to receive such salaries commencing with the month of January, 1982. Until said date, said elected officials shall continue to receive the salaries established by Ordinance No. 2176, adopted December, 1971.]


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and posting or publication, as required by law.

Passed by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular, open meeting this 17th day of June, 1985.
