

ORDINANCE NO. 2881

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FINDING THE EXISTANCE OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF ANTICIPATED REVENUES DURING THE BUDGETARY PERIOD COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 1985, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The Kirkland City Council finds that the following sums so indicated have been received and are in the excess of anticipated revenues estimated:

REVENUES

A. Current Expense

1. Charges for Service \$ 75,000.00

B. City Hall Maintenance

1. Resources Forward 100,000.00

From said excess revenues and funds the following expenditures during the 1985 budgetary period are hereby authorized:

EXPENDITURES

A. Current Expense Fund

1. Personnel Services \$ 75,000.00

B. City Hall Maintenance Fund

1. Other Services and Charges 50,000.00

2. Capital Outlay 50,000.00

Total City Hall Maintenance Fund \$ 100,000.00

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and posting or publication, as required by law.
