

ORDINANCE No. 2897

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO WATERS AND SURFACE CRAFT REQUIRING EVIDENCE OF PAYMENT OF KING COUNTY OPTIONAL BOAT TAX AND ADDING A NEW SECTION TO CHAPTER 14.04 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Whereas, King County has pursuant to state law, elected to impose a county boat tax; and

Whereas, the receipts from said tax fund in part, the operation of the King County Marine Patrol; and

Whereas, by interlocal agreement the King County Marine Patrol provides patrol and enforcement services within the waters of Lake Washington subject to the jurisdiction of the City of Kirkland, now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby added to Chapter 14.04 of the Kirkland Municipal Code, a new section to read as follows:

14.04.070 Evidence of payment of King County boat tax required. It shall be unlawful for any person to moor, store or operate a vessel, the use of which is subject to King County Ordinance 6595, as amended (optional county boat tax), within the City of Kirkland without displaying thereon evidence of compliance with said county ordinance. Any fines which may be collected for violation of this section shall be in addition to the tax required by said county ordinance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and posting or publication, as required by law.
