## ORDINANCE NO. 2942

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE BILLING OF CHARGES FOR REFUSE, WATER AND SEWER SERVICES FURNISHED BY THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND AMENDING SECTION 15.20.010 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 15.20.010 of the Kirkland Municipal Code be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

15.20.010 Person billed. Charges for refuse, water and sewer services [{as-well-as-all-ether utility-services}] furnished by the city shall be billed to the owner of the property to which the services are rendered[7]. Provided that when the owner and tenant in possession, in writing, file with the city, a request that the billing be sent to the tenant, the city manager acting through the director of administration and finance, may at his discretion, grant such a request, subject to such reasonable conditions as he finds are appropriate; notwithstanding to whom the billing is sent, the obligation for payment shall be the joint and several responsibility of the property owner and the tenant.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and posting or publication, as required by law.
