

ORDINANCE NO. 2974

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO CHANGING THE NAME OF OLD "LAKE WASHINGTON BOULEVARD LYING SOUTH OF SR 520 WITHIN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND TO "NORTHEAST 35TH PLACE".

Whereas, that portion of Lake Washington Boulevard lying south of SR 520 lies partially within the corporate limits of the City of Kirkland, the City of Bellevue and the Town of Clyde Hill; and

Whereas, said Boulevard south of SR 520 has, by the City of Bellevue and the Town of Clyde Hill, been changed to "Northeast 35th Place"; and

Whereas, the Kirkland Department of Public Works has requested that that portion of Lake Washington Boulevard within the City of Kirkland lying south of SR 520 be re-named Northeast 35th Place; and

Whereas, the City Council in public hearing has received and considered the comments of the general public as to the proposed change of street name; and

Whereas, the City Council believes that it is within the public interest to re-name said street consistent with its name identification within the City of Bellevue and the Town of Clyde Hill and to designate said Lake Washington Boulevard south of SR 520 as Northeast 35th Place; now, therefore,

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. That certain public street within the City of Kirkland and south of SR 520 now known as Lake Washington Boulevard, is hereby re-named Northeast 35th Place.

Section 2. The City administration is hereby directed to take all steps necessary and required to effect changing the name of that portion of Lake Washington Boulevard lying south of SR 520 to Northeast 35th Place, including the installation of street identification signs, notifying the U.S. Postal Service, King County, the State Department of Transportation, the appropriate police, fire and other emergency response services and such other public and private entities as may be appropriate.


This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage and publication as required by law.

PASSED by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular open meeting this 2nd day of September, 1986.


