AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO PARKING FOR DISABLED PERSONS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 12.44 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding a new section to be known as Section 12.44.110, entitled Parking Places Reserved for Physically Disabled Persons, and to read as follows:

12.44.110 Parking Places Reserved for Physically Disabled Persons. Except as otherwise provided in this section, it is a traffic infraction, with a monetary penalty of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for any person to park a vehicle in a parking place provided on private property, in a roadway, way open to the public or public right-of-way or on public property reserved for physically disabled persons. Such parking space shall be indicated by a pavement marking or vertical sign including the international symbol of access as portrayed in RCW 70.92.120. Persons using vehicles displaying the special license plate, card, or decal as provided in RCW Chapter 46.16 shall be permitted to park in such parking spaces. Nothing in this section limits the right of the City to pursue other lawful criminal, civil or equitable remedies to abate or correct violations relating to parking places reserved for physically disabled persons, including impoundment of violator vehicles pursuant to Section 12.40.010 and RCW 46.61.565(6).

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.


