

ORDINANCE No. 3006

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND
RELATING TO IMPROPER USE OF PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of
Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 19.04 of the Kirkland Municipal
code is hereby amended by adding a new section to be known
as Section 19.04.010 entitled Obstructions in Right-of-
Way, and to read as follows:

19.04.010 Obstructions in Right-of-Way.

It is a simple crime for any person to drop, deposit,
leave or permit to be deposited upon a street or sidewalk
or within other portions of the public right-of-way any
object, structure, construction material, equipment or
other natural or artificial thing which obstructs or tends
to obstruct vehicles or persons traveling thereon; except
as provided in Section 19.04.050 or otherwise authorized
by City ordinance or specific permission of the City.

Such a deposit is a public nuisance. As an alter-
native to, or in addition to, issuance of a citation for
violation of this section, the City may take such action
as may be necessary to abate the nuisance. Whenever the
nuisance poses a present danger, the City has the author-
ity to cause its immediate removal.

Any person violating this section shall be liable to
the City for the costs of the removal of the nuisance.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and
effect five days from and after its passage by the
Kirkland City council and publication, as required by law.
