

ORDINANCE NO. 3052

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO CHANGING THE NAMES OF NE 106TH STREET AND A PORTION OF NE 108TH STREET, PUBLIC STREETS WITHIN THE JUANITA SLOUGH AREA OF KIRKLAND TO "FORBES CREEK DRIVE."

Whereas, there has been presented to the Kirkland City Council, a request by owners of property along what is now known as NE 106th Street and a portion of NE 108th Street between Market Street and 116th Avenue NE within the Juanita Slough area of Kirkland to change the name of said streets to "Forbes Creek Drive."

Whereas, the City Council in public hearing has received and considered the comments of the general public as to the proposed renaming to Forbes Creek Drive.

Whereas, the City Council believes that it is within the public interest to rename said street and designate the same as Forbes Creek Drive; now, therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1: Northeast 106th Street, between Market Street and 108th Avenue NE, together with the extension thereof from 108th Avenue NE to 116th Avenue NE that is to be constructed and dedicated as public right-of-way as a part of the conditions of Approval of the Park at Forbes Creek PUD, are hereby renamed and designated Forbes Creek Drive, provided that this name change shall not become effective until the portion to be constructed, which passes through "The Park at Forbes Creek" site has been constructed, dedicated, and accepted by the City of Kirkland.

It is not the intention of this ordinance to change the address of any residence that has the street address of 22nd Avenue.

Section 2: The City administration is hereby directed to take all steps necessary and required to effect changing the name of these before-mentioned streets to Forbes Creek Drive, including the installation of street identification signs, notifying the U.S. Postal Service, King County, the State Department of Transportation, Evergreen Hospital, and such other public and private entities as may be appropriate.

This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage and posting or publication as required by law.
