

ORDINANCE 3131

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO SHORELINE CONDITIONAL USE PERMITS, PROVIDING THAT APPLICATIONS FOR SAME SHALL BE PROCESSED USING THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 152 OF ORDINANCE 2740, AS AMENDED, THE KIRKLAND ZONING CODE, (PROCESS IIB) AND AMENDING SUBSECTION 24.06.045(b) OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1: Subsection 24.06.045(b) relating to the procedures by which Shoreline Conditional Use permits shall be reviewed and decided upon, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

24.06.45(b) Procedures. The City will review and decide upon each application for a conditional use permit under the Shoreline Management Act and the Shoreline Master Program, using the provisions of Chapter ~~[155]~~ 152 of Ordinance 2740, as amended (the Kirkland Zoning Code) to the extent that those provisions do not conflict with the provisions of this chapter. Where a conflict exists, provisions of this chapter shall be followed.


Section 2: This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.


