ORDINANCE NO. 3141

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO DESIGNATION OF THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER FOR THE CITY, PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES IN SUMMARY FORM, AND AMENDING SECTIONS 1.08.015 AND 1.08.017 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 1.08.015 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.08.015 Designation of Official Newspaper.

The City shall annually by council resolution designate an official newspaper. The newspaper so designated must qualify as a legal newspaper under RCW Chapter 65.16 [and shall be determined each year upon the basis bids received pursuant to RGW 35-23-352(4)].

Section 2. Section 1.08.017 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.08.017 Publication of Ordinances in Summary

All ordinances passed by the city council shall be published verbatim in accordance with the requirements of Section 1.08.010; provided, however, in lieu of such verbatim publication, a summary of the ordinance may be published. Such summary must be approved by the city council and shall include:

- 1. The name of the city;
- 2. The number of the ordinance:
- A descriptive title of the ordinance;
- 4. A section-by-section summary of the ordinance;
- 5. Any other information which the city council finds is necessary to provide a complete summary;
- 6. A statement that the full text of the ordinance will be mailed without charge to any

person upon request.

If the ordinance to be summarized contains [previsions regarding taxation or penalties or contains] legal descriptions of real property, then any summary which identifies affected property may do so by address, legal description, vicinity sketch, or other reasonable means [the sections containing this matter shall be published in full and shall not be summarized. When a legal description of real property is involved, a notice shall also include the street address or addresses of the property described if any. In the case of descriptions covering more than one street address, the street addresses of the four corners of the area described shall meet this requirement].

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication as required by law.
