ORDINANCE NO. 3151

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON DECLARING THE NECESSITY TO TAKE OR DAMAGE FOR PUBLIC USE CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY AND REAL PROPERTY INTERESTS WITHIN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FOR PARK PURPOSES.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Council finds that the taking and damaging of certain real property and real property interests hereinafter described, is for a public use and necessary to the inhabitants of the City of Kirkland, in order to acquire real property and real property interests in the north Rose Hill area for park purposes.

Section 2. The real property and real property interests required to be appropriated, taken, or damaged are situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington and specifically described as follows:

Lots 15 and 16, Pettit's Alder Park Addition to Kirkland, according to plat threof recorded in Volume 21 of Plats, page 66, in King County, Washington.

Compensation and damage awards for the acquisition of said real property and real property interests shall be paid from the City of Kirkland Park and Municipal Facilities Cumulative Reserve Fund.

Section 3. The Kirkland City Manager is authorized and directed to immediately begin and prosecute action and proceedings in the manner provided by law to purchase, condemn, take, damage, appropriate and otherwise acquire the lands and other property rights and privileges necessary to carry out the purposes of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
