

ORDINANCE NO. 3170*Repealed by 3238*

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON RELATING TO THE KIRKLAND WATER-SEWER SYSTEM, ADJUSTING CERTAIN RATES FOR WATER SERVICE, AND AMENDING CHAPTER 15.24 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 15.24.020 of the Kirkland Municipal Code relating to monthly service rate for water service is hereby amended to read as follows:

**15.24.020 Basic water rate--Residential.**

Basic residential water rates are as follows:

- (1) Single family residence - \$4.50 per month;
- (2) Multi-family residence, including duplexes - \$2.50 per month per unit or apartment;
- (3) The single family basic monthly rate shall include two hundred [fifty] cubic feet of water consumed;
- (4) The basic rates shall be charged whether the premises are occupied or vacant.

Section 2. Section 15.24.040 of the Kirkland Municipal Code relating to monthly service and consumption rates for water service is hereby amended to read as follows:

**15.24.040 Water consumption charge.**

In addition to the basic monthly rate, the charge for water consumed during the billing period (bi-monthly) shall be:

- (1) For residential customers:

Winter rate - [eighty] ninety-three cents per one hundred cubic feet of water consumed;

Summer rate - ninety-nine cents per one hundred cubic feet of water consumed;

(2) For nonresidential customers:

Winter rate - [Eighty-five] Ninety-eight cents per one hundred cubic feet of water consumed;

Summer rate - One Dollar and four cents per one hundred cubic feet of water consumed;

(3) Where the basic rate includes some water consumption (single-family residential customers) the consumption rate shall be calculated on water consumed in excess of the amount included in the basic rate.

(4) For the purposes of this section "summer rate" is defined as the four consecutive months of peak water consumption between May and September, inclusive, of each year.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
