AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND PROVIDING THAT THE HEARING EXAMINER SHALL HAVE JURISDICTION TO HEAR AND DECIDE LAND USE DEVELOPMENT PERMITS REQUIRED FOR CITY PARKS WITHIN RS, RSX, AND P LAND USE ZONES AND ADDING A NEW SECTION TO CHAPTER 3.34 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby added to Chapter 3.34 of the Kirkland Municipal Code (Hearing Examiner) a new Section to read as follows:

Section 3.34.065 Hearing Examiner Jurisdiction - Development Permits for City Parks in RS, RSX, and P Zones.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Municipal Code or any other Ordinance of the City, including Ordinance 2740, the Hearing Examiner shall have jurisdiction and authority to hear and decide Land Use Development Permits required for development, construction or improvement of City-owned parks located within RS, RSX, and P Zones, as established on the Kirkland Zoning Map, provided further that any such hearings shall be held in the evening. The Hearing Examiner shall exercise this authority using Process IIB (Chapter 152 of Ordinance 2740), which provides that the Hearing Examiner's decision shall be a recommendation to the City Council. The authority given to the Hearing Examiner by this Section shall expire December 31, 1991.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
