ORDINANCE NO. 3248

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE RATES TO BE CHARGED BY THE CITY KIRKLAND FOR COLLECTION OF RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE, INCLUDING CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS, AND AMENDING SECTION 16.12.025 AND SUBSECTION 16.10.030(1) OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 16.12.025, Qualified senior citizens rate, is hereby amended to read as follows:

16.12.025 Qualified senior citizens rate.

The solid waste collection rate to be charged to a qualified low-income senior citizen single-family residential customer shall be sixty percent of the rate set forth in Section 16.12.030(1)(A).

For the purposes of this section "qualified low-income senior citizen" means a person who meets the following qualifications:

- (1) Resides in a single-family residential unit;
- (2) Customer and spouse, if married, must be sixty-two years of age or older;
- (3) Income received by customer and spouse, if married, shall not exceed (from all sources of income) the-following tevels:-(i)-single-person,-seven-hundred twenty-seven-dollars-and-fifty-cents-per month,-(ii)-married-persons,-one-thousand ninety-one-dollars-and-thirty-four-cents per-month, as to either single persons or married persons as the case may be, the annual low income index generated by King County for use in federal housing and community development block grant programs in King County;
- (4) Proof of qualification, including verification of income level, shall be made by affidavit of qualification signed under oath by the senior citizen customer and then filed with the city. The

affidavit of qualification form shall be furnished by the city. (Ord. 3198, Sec. 1, 1989)

(5) A single-family residential customer who is either disabled or blind, according to Social Security criteria, and who also meets the qualifications of subparagraphs (1) and (3) shall for the purposes of this section be a qualified senior citizen customer.

Section 2. Subsection 16.12.030(1)
Residential Single-Family collection rates, is
hereby amended to read as follows:

16.12.030 Collection rates.

The rates to be charged for solid waste collection service in the city shall be as follows:
