

ORDINANCE O-3267*Repealed by 3946*

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND
RELATING TO FIRE ACCESS ROADS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of
the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 21.32 of the
Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended
by the addition of a new section to be
known as Section 21.32.045, entitled UFC
Section 10.207 amended, and to read as
follows:

21.32.045 UFC Section 10.207 amended.


Section 10.207 of the Uniform Fire
Code is amended to read as follows:

Section 10.207 Fire Apparatus
Access Roads. Fire apparatus access
roads shall be provided and
maintained in accordance with the
provisions of this section. Fire
apparatus access roads shall be
required for every building
hereafter constructed as provided by
operating policies of the Director
of Fire Services. The Director of
Fire Services is directed to develop
and publish rules and regulations
for fire access roads. The rules
and regulations shall include
provisions so that access roads of
not less than 20 feet wide will be
available to serve apartment or
light industrial buildings.


This ordinance shall be in force and
