ORDINANCE NO. 0-3283

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO PRIVATE INVESTIGATORS AND PRIVATE GUARDS AND REPEALING KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE (KMC) CHAPTER 7.28.

WHEREAS, the State legislature passed Chapters 328 and 334 of the Laws of Washington, 1991, adopting uniform statewide licensing standards regulating private detective and private security guard agencies and employees, and substantially preempting local jurisdictions from regulating the private detective and private security guard industries, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Chapter 7.28 KMC (Ordinance 2270, Section 1), is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 2</u>. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
