### ORDINANCE NO. 3295

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO WATER/SEWER SYSTEM CUSTOMER RATES PROVIDING FOR INCREASES IN SAID RATES AND AMENDING CHAPTER 15.24 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>: Table 15.24.020 of the Kirkland Municipal Code which establishes the monthly water charge required to be paid to the City by customers of the Kirkland Water System is amended to read as follows:

<u>Section 3.</u> QUALIFIED SENIOR CITIZENS RATE - The water and wastewater user rates to be charged to a qualified low-income senior citizen single-family residential customer shall be:

## WATER

- (1) 50% of the Basic Charge (includes 200 cubic feet of water consumed) as set forth in table 15.24.020.
- (2) Water consumption charge as set forth in Table 15.24.024.

## <u>SEWER</u>

(1) 75% of the Single-Family Residential Rate set forth in Table 15.24.070.

For the purposes of this section "qualified low-income senior citizen" means a person who meets the following qualifications:

- (1) Resides in a single-family residential unit;
- (2) Customer and spouse, if married, must be sixty-two years of age or older;
- (3) Income received by customer and spouse, if married, shall not exceed (from all sources of income), as to either single persons or married persons as the case may be, the annual low income index generated by the county for use in federal housing and community development block grant programs in the county;
- (4) Proof of qualification, including verification of income level, shall be made by affidavit of qualification signed under oath by the senior citizen customer and then filed with the city. The affidavit of qualification form shall be furnished by the city;

(5) A single-family residential customer who is either disabled or blind, according to Social Security criteria, and who also meets the qualifications of sub-paragraphs (1) and (3) of this section shall for the purposes of this section be a qualified senior citizen customer. (Ord. 3248 1, 1991: Ord. 3198 1, 1989).

<u>Section 4</u>. Effective date for new rates: The monthly service and consumption rates for water and sewer customers established in this ordinance shall go into effect and become the rates to be charged as of December 1, 1991 provided, however, that the water consumption charge for both water and sewer as to those customers billed on the City of Kirkland billing cycles number 2, number 4, and number 5 shall go into effect January 1, 1992.

<u>Section 5</u>. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication pursuant to Section 1.08.017 Kirkland Municipal Code in summary form attached to the original of this Ordinance and by this reference approved by the City Council, as required by law.
