

ORDINANCE NO. 3298

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DECLARING UNCOLLECTIBLE CERTAIN LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT RECEIVABLES.

WHEREAS, the Auditor of the State of Washington has conducted an audit of Local Improvement District projects of the City of Kirkland which have been completed and on which the debt has been paid off, and

WHEREAS, the State Auditor has recommended the City write off certain Local Improvement District receivables as uncollectible, Now, Therefore

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1: The following Local Improvement District receivables should be written off as receivables of the City of Kirkland because they are uncollectible:


