AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE STANDING, STOPPING AND PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND AMENDING CHAPTER 12.44 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION 12.44.041.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 12.44 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended and supplemented by adding thereto a new section 12.44.041 to read as follows:

Section 12.44.041. Temporary no parking areas.

- 1. The director of public works or his delegate and/or the chief of police or his delegate are authorized to place on any portion of any street "no parking" signs mounted on traffic barricades or other temporary standards specifying the day(s) and time(s) for the purpose of:
 - a. Cleaning or sweeping said street or
 - b. Repair or maintenance of said street right-of-way, including curb, sidewalk or utility facilities or
 - c. When in the opinion of the traffic engineer the parking of motor vehicles on said street would interfere with traffic or pedestrian circulation safety or
 - d. Use of said street by the holder of a parade run or special event permit issued by the city.
- 2. It is a traffic infraction for any person to park, stand or stop a motor vehicle in

any portion of a city street signed "no parking" pursuant to subsection 1 above. Any police officer or parking enforcement person is authorized to issue a parking citation and ticket for any infraction of this section. Any motor vehicle parked in violation of subsection 1 above may be impounded pursuant to the provisions of Section 12.44.045.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
