

ORDINANCE 3328

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT, WASTE STREAM REDUCTION BY RECYCLING, ADOPTING A RECYCLING PROGRAM FOR MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS, ESTABLISHING RATES FOR COLLECTION AND AMENDING SECTIONS 16.08.12(2) and 16.12.030 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby added to subsection 16.08.012(2) a new paragraph to read as follows:

16.08.012(2)G. Multi-Family Residential Recycling. Multi-family residential customers may choose and by the city are urged to choose to participate in separation and placement for collection for recycling the following materials: Newspapers, mixed papers, and recyclable bottles, cans and plastic containers. Recyclable materials will be collected on the same pickup schedule as solid waste collections. Recyclable materials shall be separated and placed in recycling bins or carts distributed by the city's solid waste collection contractor. Multi-family residential customers using garbage can collection service will receive three recycling bins for recyclable materials per residential unit. Multi-family residential customers using containers will receive two or more recycling carts as determined by the size of the solid waste container:

Section 2. Section 16.12.030 is hereby amended read as follows:

16.12.030 Collection rates.

The rates to be charged for solid waste collection service in the city shall be as follows:

- (4) Wherever detachable containers are used having a capacity for which a rate has not been established, the director of administration and finance is authorized to establish a rate for such container, which shall be consistent with the ratio of the container capacity to rate charged for the rate herein established.
- (5) In addition to the collection rates established in subsections (1), (2) and (3) above, there shall be included a county board of health hazardous waste charge as follows:


- (i) For each single-family residential customer the amount of sixty cents per month;
- (ii) For each multifamily and nonresidential (commercial) customer the sum of five dollars and twenty-four cents per month.

Section 2. Effective date for new rates: The monthly rates established in this ordinance shall go into effect and become the rates to be charged as of November 1, 1992.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
